Internal energy and 1st Law 4/17/14 Physics 115 11 • st1 Law of Thermodynamics: The change in internal energy of a system equals the heat transfer into the system plus the work done by the system (Essentially: conservation of energy) $\Delta U = Q - W$ Work done by the system Example: expanding gas pushes a piston Work done on the system
